## **Board of Trustees Policy**

### **GOVERNMENT RELATIONS POLICY**

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Spectrum Charter School ("Charter School") to maintain harmonious relations with government officials.

The Board shall have the authority to enter into agreements with any department, agency, office, board or commission of Monroeville, or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or the United States, when, in the opinion of the Board, such agreement will further the efficient and effective administration of public education.


Such agreements may include but are not limited to:


1. Requests for Police Assistance are to be made to the Monroeville Police Department.
2. The Monroeville Police Department should be notified of:
  - a. A change in the time of regular dismissals.
  - b. Athletic events.
  - c. Special events, including night activities.
  - d. Unsafe highway conditions affecting the safety of pupils, etc.
3. Emergency Requests

In the event of an emergency, the CEO or designee, is to call the policy emergency number, 9-1-1, and request assistance in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding in place with the local law enforcement.
